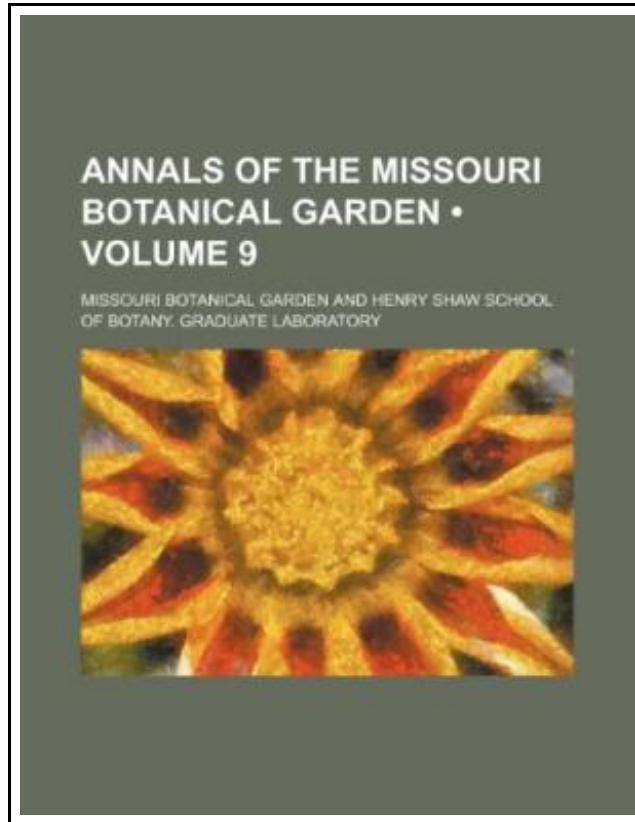

Recent studies in this family have emphasized the necessity of detailed examination of the various generic units before any general developmental theory is possible. The present author holds that there is no basis for a study of phylogeny equal to a taxonomic review of the species and genera involved. Details of specific distinction are most important in illustrating the steps in progressive differentiation. The present view held is that phylogenetic theories that do not take into account the apparently trivial details of specific characterizations are not dependable, since they are subject to too many sources of error.
