This is a little cap OLD-FASHIONED LAMPS with two tubes sticking up through it, and the wicks go down into the oil tank. You can unscrew it. It soaks up twice as much oil and gives three times as much light as one wick would. On this you don't unscrew the cap, but put the oil in through a little place there. You can lower and raise the wicks of this one by this little tube. In this lamp they had a single wick, and...
